ONE RAP

President: We will now retire for the Cross of Malta.

After everyone is in their station **RAP GAVEL THREE TIMES.**

District President gives welcome and INTRODUCES the Hosting President.

Start the District Meeting after welcome.

President: This District Meeting is called to order. The Officers will take their respective stations. All persons not members of the Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars will kindly retire.

President: Madam Guard/Mister Guard, close the door and allow no one to enter until the opening services have been concluded.

Guard: Madam/Mister President, your orders have been obeyed.

President: Madam Conductress/Mister Conductor (and Assistant Conductress/Conductor), satisfy yourself that all present are entitled to remain.

TWO RAPS

Conductress/Conductor and Assist Conductress/Conductor: Madam President, I find all, except those standing, in possession of the official membership dues card for the current calendar year.

If someone is standing: **President:** Is there someone from this (or these) member's auxiliary that can vouch for her. (Anyone can vouch; it does not need to be the Treasurer any more.) If no one is from their Auxiliary, then a motion is needed to allow the sister to remain.

President: Madam Secretary/Mister Secretary, you will call the roll of District Officers.

THREE RAPS TO SEAT THEM

President: Madam Secretary/Mister Secretary, you will call the Roll of Past Dept. Presidents and Past District Presidents

THREE RAPS TO SEAT THEM

President: Chaplain will now offer the opening prayer.

Conductress: Color Bearers, Altar position.

President: Parade Rest.

OPENING PRAYER

ALL: Amen

President: Attention!

Conductress/Conductor: Color Bearers, Right and Left Face, Forward March!

Conductress/Conductor: About Face.

Patriotic Instructor: Let us be ever mindful of our duties as members of the Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, to see that our flag is never desecrated and to teach the people of our land what this means and to see that all are instructed in the pledge to the flag.

President: You will salute and give pledge to the Flag.

I PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE to the Flag of the United States of America and to the Republic for which it stands, (pause) one nation under God (pause) INDIVISIBLE (pause) with LIBERTY and JUSTICE FOR ALL.

President: We will now sing the National Anthem, SALUTE

President: Attention!

President: Madam Conductress/Mister Conductor, with the colors you will retire and escort our Dept. Representative into the room.

TWO RAPS

Guard: Madam President, the Conductress/Conductor with the colors and our Dept. Representative.

President: Let's give our Dept. President or Dept. Representative a big welcome to our District.

(If you have other Dept. Officers or Past Dept. Presidents, OR Current District Presidents from other districts to escort, leave your Conductress/Conductor and Color Bearers standing at the Altar. Then introduce your first guest, if there is no one to escort after the Dept.

Representative, seat your Conductress/Conductor and Color Bearers, then introduce your Representative.

President: Madam Conductress/ Mister Conductor, with the Colors you will retire and escort our other guest(s).

President: Officers take your station.

Conductress/Conductor: About face. **President:** We are about to leave this Auxiliary room. Let us endeavor to so regulate our conduct that it will reflect credit on ourselves and bring honor to our organization. I now declare this meeting closed with the retiring of the colors to reopen at the sound of the gavel. Conductress/Conductor: About Face. Conductress/Conductor: Two's right face. As soon as the Patriotic Instructor picks up her flag you give the command **President:** SALUTE! Conductress/Conductor: Twos' Left, March. As soon as the Colors have left the room **President: ATTENTION!** ONE RAP OF THE GAVEL
