One of the reasons I love the Fall season, is it's just time to be thankful and reflect on how blessed we are! It's a time to enjoy the beautiful colors that dot the tree line, the crisp air, bonfires, Halloween parties and Thanksgiving gatherings. It's a great time to do something special for the Veterans and/or families who may not be able to see or experience what we do each day? Take pictures of "FALL" scenery, and put them in a photo frame and album, press colorful leaves make a collage with maybe a cute sign like ("Enjoy the Fall Season, but please don't fall") or whatever you feel is a Hallmark saying.

If able, go into the hospitals, VA Centers, Nursing Homes, or visit inbound Veterans who stay in their homes, and maybe make some smores or make turkey's using their hands with them, take them to a Halloween Party Thanksgiving Dinner. You'll be blessed, blessing others!

HOSPITAL/VA FOCUS: This month we are focusing on Wilkes-Barre VA Medical Center (WBVA), located at 1111 East End Boulevard, Wilkes-Barre PA which was established in 1946 (after two (2) years of planning and fundraising starting in 1944). WBVA has 173 operating beds, 58 hospital beds, including 30 inpatient care, 24 inpatient mental health and 4 surgical beds, 105 community living center (nursing home) beds, and 10 beds in their substance abuse residential rehabilitation program. 1,360 full time employees, including 228 nursing staff and 101 physicians who are dedicated clinical and professional staff, and many volunteers. Maryann Pauline (D11-Aux 8253), Representative and Ann Ray M. Begis (D12-Aux 3432), Deputy both see that the needs of our hospitalized Veterans are met. One of the big draws for the residents is playing cards and enjoy yelling out BINGO when volunteers are able to run bingo games. Please take time to stop in and see "Through a Hero's Eyes" Veteran Art Gallery starting Sunday December 4, 2022, 10 a.m. to Friday, March 3, 2023, at 11:00 a.m.

Recognition time: This year we would like to go out of our way to show our appreciation to Doctors/ Nurses/ Staff/ Hospital/ Volunteers / VAVS Representatives and Deputies who go above and beyond what they do on a regular basis. One Auxiliary in each division that has the best promotion honoring these special people will receive a citation. Support your volunteers by thanking them for their service and recognize their contributions! A simple thank you goes a long way, but you can also print a Certificate of Appreciation from the website at www.vfwauxiliary.org/resources and present it to them at an auxiliary meeting, or a volunteer appreciation event.

National Membership Awards


