Were you installed as a new Treasurer recently? When Treasurers change for any reason, the IRS Form 8822B, Change of Address or Responsible Party, must be completed and returned according to the instructions on the form.

Your 990-N e-postcard can be submitted now, so don't delay. Remember to make sure it has been "Accepted" and not just "Submitted." A copy of the confirmation of acceptance by the IRS must be sent to Department Headquarters.

The program book and individual programs are on the Department's website, along with some updated forms under "Resources," so please be sure to check out vfwauxpa.org regularly for relevant information to help you be successful throughout the year.
