Did you know that VFW Auxiliaries are able to apply for Uniting for Veterans grants?

The Uniting for Veterans Grant is a matching donation grant of up to \$1,500 available to VFW Posts and its Auxiliaries for monetary, food, or item donations to local food banks, pantries or homeless relief organizations in their communities. The VFW Foundation will provide a \$1 match for every pound of food or dollar donated to food insecurity organizations. The VFW Foundation will provide a \$1 match for every \$1 spent purchasing qualified items to donate to a homeless shelter or a \$1 match for every \$1 donated to a homeless relief organization. A minimum of 500 pounds or \$500 must be met each time you are submitting an application in order to qualify. A Post and its Auxiliary may apply separately, each must have their own distinct project.

VFW Auxiliaries applying for a VFW UFV Grant can download the grant at wfw.org/UFV. Please note, funds are not provided to VFW Posts or Auxiliaries. If approved, funds are submitted to the donation location listed on the application.

December brings the holiday season. Hard to believe that the end of 2025 is around the corner. Are you an auxiliary member of at least one year, in good standings, and 21 years of age or older and have decided to go back to school to further your education? What about your spouse, son or daughter if you have any children that are at least 21 years old? Then you or your family member should consider applying for the Continuing Education Scholarship. All you need to do is answer 7 questions and write a 300-word essay and submit your entry to National Headquarters by February 15, 2026. Simple process and great chance to earn some money to assist with tuition for your schooling. Now is the time to do something for yourself or your family members.

Moving into December, please remember that there are still Art Scholarship programs that students can take advantage of. The Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest, the 3-Dimensional Patriotic Art Contest and you can even assist your Youth Chairman by also sharing the Illustrating America Art Program to capture all ages of students. Be sure that you get the information out to the same locations that you shared the Voice of Democracy and Patriot Pen information out to. Look at different groups to share these programs with such as your local art stores, your local craft shops, your local Starbucks and Dunkin Donut stores. Find places where young adults hang out and might see the application information. If you happen to have any arcades in your local area, this could be a good location as well. Remember to place these up in your VFW as well as local businesses, with their permission of course.

As the November General Orders highlighted some of the talented young Americans from prior submissions, who knows if you may not be lucky enough to receive some amazing entries yourself. We just need to continue to share the program details and give these young kids and young adults the opportunity to show off their talents.

Reasons why it is important to celebrate military birthdays:

- •Honoring tradition: Military birthdays are opportunities to commemorate the historical founding of each branch and its role in national defense.
- •Reinforcing heritage: They serve as a way to teach new generations of service members about their branch's history, values, and the sacrifices of those who came before them.
- •Building community: Celebrations reinforce a shared sense of purpose and camaraderie, strengthening the collective identity of the service members and creating a stronger sense of belonging.
- •Inspiring future generations: Celebrating the history and achievements of the military can inspire current and future service members and the public to recognize and honor the armed forces.

Each date marks a significant moment in the branch's establishment, often during periods of national need. The branches in chronological order of their founding are:

Branch	Birthday	Founding Event
National Guard	December 13, 1636	Traces its roots to the first militia regiments in the Massachusetts Bay Colony.
Army	June 14, 1775	The date the Continental Congress authorized the enlistment of riflemen to serve the United Colonies, establishing the Continental Army.
Navy	October 13, 1775	The Continental Congress authorized the purchase of the first two armed vessels, leading to the Continental Navy.
Marine Corps	November 10, 1775	The Continental Congress resolved to raise two battalions of Marines, a decision famously made at Tun Tavern in Philadelphia.
Coast Guard	August 4, 1790	President George Washington signed the Tariff Act, which authorized the construction of ten revenue cutters to enforce trade laws and prevent smuggling.
Air Force	September 18, 1947	The passage of the National Security Act of 1947 established the U.S. Air Force as a separate and independent military branch.
Space Force	December 20, 2019	Established with the signing of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020, becoming the newest branch.

Learning the difference between VAVS vs. Hospital Program

VAVS Program: The Veterans Affairs Dept. created the **V**eterans **A**ffairs **V**oluntary **S**ervice program for organizations to serve in VA Medical Centers. Members participate in this government-run program.

Hospital Program: VFW Auxiliary establishes relationships with hospitals, nursing homes, veterans' homes, VA facilities, and other facilities where veterans are served.

Hospital Volunteers

Who can be a volunteer: Any member in good standing can volunteer at a facility in the name of the VFW Auxiliary if that member has been approved by the Auxiliary to do so. Members can volunteer alone or with a group of members and non-members.

Qualifications, Assignments and Orientation

A volunteer must:

- Have a willingness to accept hospital standards, orientation, conduct and supervision.
- Possess a clean and neat appearance.
- Be physically able to perform assigned tasks.
- Have a sense of responsibility, dependability, and stability on the job.
- Demonstrate a friendly, business-like approach to volunteer work, with honest sentiment and not sentimentality, maintaining the veteran's dignity and pride.

Every facility will have its own set of qualifications and rules that members should fully understand and comply.
