VETERANS & FAMILY SUPPORTGENERAL ORDERS #7January 2024

After the Holidays it is Important to Remember Our Veterans! After all the attention during December, January can be a huge letdown for our Veterans, especially shut-ins or in facilities. Contact local VA Hospitals, nursing homes, and Veteran aid centers to see if your Auxiliary can provide volunteers or items. Send "thinking of you" cards to the Veterans (if you can obtain a list) or send one card to hang on the facility's community bulletin board. Gather a few Auxiliary members and visit with the Veteran residents in their community room – take goodies and sit with the Veterans to hear their stories. Please coordinate with the facility to arrange the date/time of gathering, number of visitors and pre-approve any items being given to the Veterans. If January isn't an option, try February and help to brighten these dark months.

The Beginning of the Year is a great time to encourage Veterans to make an appointment with a VFW Accredited Service Officer – to enroll in the VA, or to review their claim, especially if there is a change in their medical status. If the Veteran is married, encourage them to make an appointment to review their claim with attention to surviving spouse benefits.

The VFW's National Veterans Service (NVS) was established to help all Veterans, service members, their families and survivors navigate the claims process. They assist in filing for disability compensation, rehabilitation and education programs, pension and death benefits, and employment and training programs; and will request hearings before the VA and the Board of Veterans Appeals to present oral arguments when needed. More than \$13 billion in compensation and pension was recouped by Veterans represented by the VFW in 2023. The VFW is proud to offer this service -- **FREE OF CHARGE** -- to all Veterans seeking assistance with the claims process.

Entry forms are found in Malta Member Resources under Youth Activities. DEADLINE for Participating Auxiliaries to get Entries to their District President is March 31,2024 and District Presidents send to Department Chairman by April 15, 2024.

Illustrating America is open to youth in grades K-8. Students will be judged on patriotic theme and technique. There are 3 age groups: K-2, 3-5, 6-8. Art must be 2 dimensional on canvas or paper, and no smaller than 8x10 or larger than 18x24. Details are available in the Program Book. 
