HOSPITAL – General Orders – October

Give our Veterans a "HUG"



Hi, if you were unable to attend our Program Training this year you might have missed my announcement that our project for the year will be our poncho's named "HUGS" because of the feelings of being wrapped in a warm hug! I can't wait for our reports at year end to find out just how many "HUGS" we were able to give our Veterans!

Our "HUG" is a fleece poncho appropriate for both male and female Veterans. Our goal is 3000!

When your "HUG" is ready – take it to your local VA or non-VA Hospital or nursing home. Or give to a veteran of your choice. Don't forget to record the number of "HUGS" you give. Year-end report question # 7. Don't forget to add the cost of fabric to question # 5.

This is a no-sew project, ANTI-PILL Fleece only! One size fits all. Fabric design — anything goes! (But remember they are adults.)



Size of finished HUG:

42" wide across shoulder 56" to 58" Length (after selvage edge is removed)

Step #1

48" by 60" Anti-Pill fleece fabric. You can trim any side selvage at this point.

step #2

Fold fleece in half length-wise to find the middle. Mark your neck/front in center of fleece with chalk; use a 4" diameter cup or saucer to measure neck/front opening.

Step #3

Cut out neck/front opening along chalk line.

Step #4

Your HUG is ready — no stitching necessary.
