VETERANS & FAMILY SUPPORT GENERAL ORDERS #3 September 2023

"Be There" for Veterans. Our Veterans are our heroes. Many return home with heavy hearts and heavy minds. We can provide them with helpful resources for when life gets rough.

September is National Suicide Prevention Month, and the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) is encouraging support of at-risk Veterans through their "Be There" campaign. The campaign provides effective ways to prevent Veteran suicide. Visit va.gov/REACH/ to learn the warning signs for suicide, find information about VA mental health and suicide prevention resources.

Sharing VA Secretary Robert Wilkie' words, "In our various communities, everyone is in a position to make a difference for a Veteran who may be at risk for suicide. A common misconception is that you need special training to talk safely about suicide risk or show concern for someone who is in distress. One simple act of kindness could help save a life. I encourage everyone this September, and beyond, to take the first step in acting as that support system." Simply "Be There" by sharing messages of support to show a Veteran that you care. Additional resources can be found at VeteransCrisisLine.net. Veterans in crisis, or having thoughts of suicide, and those who know a Veteran in crisis can call 988 press 1 to connect with qualified Department of Veterans Affairs responders 24/7.

Show your concern about the rate of suicide among veterans by wearing the Auxiliary Suicide Awareness Prevention Pin (a blue tear drop with the Auxiliary logo and combat boots at vfwstore.org) Print and share the Veteran & Military Suicide Awareness Stickers found in Malta, under Member Resources, under Veterans & Family Support.



The VFW teamed up with nationwide organizations: Give an Hour, Campaign to Change Direction, One Mind, PatientsLikeMe and the Elizabeth Dole Foundation to combat emotional stress. Go to The Veterans & Family Support page at vfwpaaux.org for a list of resources.

NOTE THIS CORRECTION: On the new Donations Cheat Sheet that was handed out at our On The Road Trainings and Program & Auxiliary Training there is a correction on where to send National VFW Military Service donations. These donations go to VFW Headquarters, 406 West 34th Street, Kansas City, MO – NOT VFW Auxiliary – 10th floor. The corrected form is on our website.

Auxiliary Officers (Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers) dues MUST be paid by December 31, or they will be relieved from their office. Please let's take care of this immediately – we do not want to wait until December! Suggesting they upgrade to Life would be the perfect solution.

Pennsylvania All State — If you have not already done so; please pull out the PA All State form from your Program Book and check off each item as you complete it. This will give you a gauge for your accomplishments as well as keep you on track for all deadlines. Take note that the All State form shows the November 30 deadline for Officers dues. Meeting this deadline will ensure that you are not receiving calls and emails regarding unpaid officers and our time will be better used serving our Veterans.
