As my last report for the Legislative Program for 2024-2025 program year, it has been an honor to represent the Department of Pennsylvania for this program. It was an eye-opening experience for me, and I learned a lot along the way. As a whole, we have all done well in representing the Department of Pennsylvania in a positive light.

I was able to report to Madam President Meintel that for the Legislative Program, we had 17 of 24 Districts, that were 100% in reporting. Of the 250 Auxiliaries in PA, 240 Auxiliaries participated in the Legislative Program. 234 Auxiliaries promoted the VFW Priority Goals this year in some way, shape or form. There were 965 members documented as communicating with their legislators this year and there were 1102 members documented as attending events where they could interact with legislators. This places the Legislative Program at 96% reporting for Department of PA!!! This is a strong showing for the Legislative Program for PA this year and I am so proud to have been able to report these numbers for sure. This is all thanks to you and all that your Auxiliaries did this program year. I thank all of you for investing the time you did this year and hope that you continue doing what you did moving forward.

Remember to stay the course. Continue to correspond with your representatives and senators to continue to let them know we are watching what is happening and that we are fighting for our Veteran's rights. Remember that Together Helping Veterans and From Our Roots to Our Branches, Extending Service to Our Veterans, No one does more for Veterans than the VFW Auxiliary!!!!!!!!!!!! The Welcome Message will appear and along the bottom will be: Welcome, Announcements, Schedule, People and More. **Click on People** and set up your user profile. Under **More**, you will find several sections. The first, Social Feed allows you to add comments and comment on or like other people's posts. Under Crown Pics, you can post messages or photos for everyone to see. Our Department Historian will post pictures in the Gallery section.
