Program Eligibility Requirements

Actively Serving

- Unaccompanied Tour or Deployment
- Parent(s)/Guardian(s)
- Single or Married with dependent child(ren)
- Drilling National Guard & Reserve

Veteran

- Honorably discharged, Active, Guard, or Reserve Veteran
- Surviving widow or widower with dependent children
- Parent(s)/Guardian(s)
- Single or Married with dependent child(ren)

VFW/Auxiliary

- Parent(s)/Guardian(s)
- Applicant has a parent in the VFW or Auxiliary in good standing or if deceased, in good standing at the time of death
- Single or Married with dependent child(ren)

Meeting basic eligibility criteria as listed above, only allows the applicant(s) to begin the process of application and assessment, eligibility does not constitute an automatic approval process for admission. Participating families with one or more children can find healing in our tranquil, rural, small-town community. Tree-lined streets connect 42 single-family homes with supportive structures such as our state-certified childcare center, gymnasium, Veteran & Family Resource Center, and computer lab.

Participating families can live in one of our beautiful homes for up to four years while working one-on-one with a personal case manager to set goals and identify areas in which they need improvement. Ideal candidates will demonstrate cooperation, willingness to learn, motivation to change and willingness to develop an attainable vision/goals for the future. All areas of life are explored; finances, career plans, education, relationships, health and wellness, needs of children, household management, etc.
